Proposed Policy Governing School Street Signage Change Requests

In response to the commission's request to draft policy language governing reimbursement requirements for requests from school officials to change street signage in the vicinity of a school, the following proposed verbiage is submitted:

Reimbursement for time and materials will be required from the requestor for changes to parking restriction signage associated with changes to arrival and dismissal times, and bus pick-up/drop-off locations requested by school officials. There will be no charge for signage changes associated with traffic engineering provisions adopted by the City of Racine to improve safety/traffic in the vicinity of a school.
