SUBJECT: CDBG Lead Service Request by City Development for 1531 Packard Ave

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Housing Division of the Department of City Development requests a \$2,500 loan for lead service replacement at 1531 Packard Avenue.

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:

A CDBG-funded housing rehabilitation project was approved by the Community Development Committee and Common Council for 1531 Packard Avenue, a duplex property in uptown. The City is acting as general contractor for work completed in the project.

A lead service water line is in need of repair above the approved CDBG budget. Staff requests a 0% loan for \$2,500 to cover the costs of the lead service line replacement to be repaid at the time of housing sale. Because of EPA regulations, this property is not eligible for a homeowner grant through the Racine Water Utility.

BUDGETARY IMPACT:

\$2,500 would be loaned through the Private Lead Service Piping Loan program and repaid in full at the time of property sale.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Staff recommends that the Loan Board of Review approve the action.
