We are requesting permission to waive formal bidding procedures for two-way radio upgrades to meet the new FCC narrow-banding radio requirements. Since all Motorola brand radios have been provided by Milwaukee 2-Way, Inc., the Purchasing Agent is recommending that these upgrades be provided by the same supplier to eliminate any potential problems with the radio equipment.

I am requesting that formal bidding procedures be waived and that the Purchasing Agent be authorized and directed to negotiate this upgrade with Milwaukee 2-Way, Inc., West Allis, WI, they being the sole provider of our Motorola radios. The estimated project cost is \$9,000 with funding available in Account 991.630.5020, Street Maintenance Radio Repeater.
