SUBJECT: Communication sponsored by Alder Horton on behalf of the City Attorney's Office submitting

the claim of Samuel Daams for consideration for disallowance.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Samuel Daams filed a claim with the City requesting \$4,135.00 for damages allegedly arising from a tree that blew down and damaged the power lines attached to his property at 1121 Hayes Avenue, on or about August 6, 2024. The City maintains that the tree in question was growing on private property, and it was the responsibility of the property owner to maintain. Therefore, the City denies liability for the damages claimed. For this reason, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office that this claim be disallowed.

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:

Samuel Daams filed a claim with the City requesting \$4,135.00 for damages allegedly arising from a tree that blew down and damaged the power lines attached to his property at 1121 Hayes Avenue, Racine, WI 53403, on or about August 6, 2024.
