DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

DEPARTMENT: Community Health Programs (CHP)

REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF: May 2007

Highlights:

- The Man Talk program reached 180 boys in 15 sessions using 20 Man Talk volunteers. Jeff Schmidt was a volunteer presenter in two sessions. This was the fifth year for Man Talk and the first year for the Woman Talk program. Woman Talk reached 122 girls at Park High School using 5 volunteers. Both programs presented positive health and teen pregnancy prevention messages.
- Jeff Schmidt presented information for a Health Class at the Racine Youthful Offenders Correctional Facility on May 22.
- Diane Lange spoke to the Tuesday Optimist Club on May 29 about teen pregnancy issues and the Man Talk project.
- A Salmonella outbreak which primarily involved the eastern part of Racine County began early in the month and continued throughout the month. Eighteen cases involved clients within our jurisdiction. One case matched a serotype of a multi-state outbreak while the remaining cases were a local outbreak. Caledonia/Mt. Pleasant was the lead agency on the investigation and we cooperated with them to obtain the epidemiological information. We continue to receive some reports of Salmonella B and continue to investigate.
- Brad Holman from the Children with Special Health Care Needs program presented an update on Medicaid and other payment sources for CSHCN to the public health nursing staff meeting on May 16.
- Representative Cory Mason was successful in presenting a bill to the Joint Finance Committee to bring \$250,000 to Racine to address infant mortality. Representative Mason has been working with the Racine Infant Mortality Coalition in the efforts to reduce the high levels of infant mortality in Racine. In this project he has worked with Mayor Becker, many people in the DHFS, and others in the state assembly and senate to introduce this measure into the budget. We await the final budget hearings.
- The Racine Infant Mortality Coalition continues to meet and plan initiatives for reducing infant mortality. The Cribs for Kids program has begun. Families needing cribs are able to apply through Next Generation Now and receive a Pack n Play and education on safe sleep practices.
