Outcome Achievements:

- Two hundred and sixty five (265) children tested for lead poisoning had blood lead levels between zero and nine ug/dL (0-9 ug/dL).
- Preliminary reports identify that eighty eight (88) children were first tested for lead poisoning; one (1) had an elevated blood lead level (>9ug/dL), or 1.1 %.
- Preliminary reports identify two hundred and seventy (270) children as being tested for lead poisoning; five (5) had an elevated blood lead level (>9ug/dL), or 1.9 %.
- The number of 2009 city dog licenses obtained to date is three thousand one hundred and twenty six (3,126).
- The number of 2009 cat licenses obtained to date is six hundred and ninety six (696).
- Eighty three (83) pet fanciers' permits have been issued in 2009.
