Re: Three-Party Agreement with the City of Racine, WisDOT and GRAEF-USA, Inc. for an Engineering Services

Contract for State Project ID: 2703-05-01, 6th Street Bridge over Root River (P-51-0064) and State Project ID:

2703-05-02, 6th Street Bridge over vacated Howe Street (P-51-0067).

We are submitting a three-party agreement between the City of Racine, WisDOT and GRAEF-USA, Inc. for the design engineering services for the above projects. This agreement is for the consultant design services for the rehabilitation of both bridges including deck overlays and associated work. This is a combined let project for one bid to reduce costs associated with various reports, environmental documents required, contractor staging, various plan sheets, standard detail and detour plans. The total amount of this agreement is \$254,269.42 with the State's share \$203,415.54 and the City's share \$50,853.88.

Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and directed to enter into a professional services agreement with GRAEF-USA, Inc. and WisDOT. If the Committee agrees, the appropriate action would be to direct the Mayor and City Clerk to sign and enter into the agreement.

Fiscal Note: Per the approved State Municipal Funding Agreement, funding for this project is an 80% cost share by WisDOT and a 20% cost chare by the City of Racine, plus 100% City costs over the funding cap specified. Funding for the project is appropriated in the 2024-33 Capital Improvement Plan.
