

Re: Racine Revitalization Partnership Request to use Pearl Street Free of Charge to Support Their May 8<sup>th</sup> Uptown Clean-Up event

Racine Revitalization Partnership, in conjunction with a local church group, is conducting a clean-up event in Uptown on Saturday, May 8, 2021. They have requested that the Pearl Street facility be made available to them free of charge to support the event. They anticipate that between five and ten truckloads (pick-up trucks) of trash and debris will be cleaned up in local yards and alleys. Additionally, they expect to have some tires.

According to the attached email, this has been standard operating procedure for this event in the past.

We recommend that the Pearl Street facility be made available free of charge to the citizens participating in this event and that Randy Eschmann determine a method of identifying each of the volunteers at drop off.
