**SUBJECT:** Communication sponsored by Mayor Mason requesting an allocation of \$9,978.78 from HOME Funds to the Two Men and A Truck for relocation costs for displaced residents from the 2200 Washington Ave complex fire.

**BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:**

After a fire incident in the third quarter of 2023 displaced 53 families for an extended period, the City of Racine collaborated with the American Red Cross and the Dekoven Center to swiftly offer temporary housing solutions. Now, to further aid these families in returning to stable living arrangements, the City is seeking approval to contract Two Men and A Truck for relocation services in the amount of \$9,978.78.

**BUDGETARY IMPACT:**

There is sufficient money in the HOME fund to support this project.

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

That the CDBG Advisory Board approves a contract in the amount of \$9,978.78 with Two Men and A Truck.
