Highlights

Date	Meeting	Purpose	Outcome
July 2025	Internal	Beach Act Water Quality Monitoring	As of July 31 th , a total of 814 water samples and 352 site surveys were completed across 15 beaches. Due to water quality issues, North Beach had one swim closure and three advisories, while Zoo Beach had one swim closure and four swim advisories.
July 2025	Internal	North and Zoo Beach Dune Delineation	The dunes at North and Zoo Beach were delineated using high precision GPS. North and Zoo Beach lost 4.85 acres of dunes since 2018 (31%), with most occurring during 2020 due to high water levels and storms.
July 2025	Great Lakes Community Conservation Corp (GLCCC) and Fund for Lake Michigan (FFLM)	North and Zoo Beach Dune Restoration	The GLCCC was contacted to plan a future dune restoration project at North and Zoo Beach. In addition, the FFLM to determine interest in funding a dune restoration project. FFLM recommended submitting a pre-proposal by August 15 th .
July 2025	GLCCC and Parks Recreation & Cultural Services (PRCS)	Samuel Myers Bioretention Cell Fencing	Permanent fencing installation was coordinated with PRCS and GLCCC around a rain garden at Samuel Myers Park.
