Ordinance No. 11-07

To create Sec. 6-195 of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine, Wisconsin relating to Security cameras.

The Common Council of the City of Racine do ordain as follows:

Part 1:

Section 6-195 of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine is hereby created to read as follows:

"Sec. 6-195. Security cameras.

1. Applicability.

The provisions of this section shall apply to every alcohol beverage establishment licensed pursuant to ch. 6, except for the following:

- a. Bona fide clubs, organized labor unions, county or local fair associations, or agricultural societies, churches, lodges or societies that have been in existence for not less than 6 months prior to the date of application, or to posts established by veterans' organizations.
- b. Charitable, eleemosynary, educational or religious organizations.
- c. Convenience food stores as defined in s. 6-36.
- d. Class "C" fermented malt beverage wholesaler as defined in s. 6-52(4).

2. Regulations.

- a. Every licensee of an establishment referenced in sub. 1, shall install, maintain in proper working order and operate during all hours the premises is

open to customers, security cameras which can produce reproducible digital color images.

b. If a time-lapse digital video recorder is operated, recorded images shall not be recorded at a slower rate than 24 hours.

c. Recorded digital image files shall be kept for a minimum of 7 days and made available upon request to the police department and other law enforcement agencies.

3. Location.

Cameras shall be placed at the exterior of the establishment so as to provide a clear full frame view of the activities occurring on the premises parking lot and in areas of the premises bordered by a city street. Additionally, cameras shall be placed at locations within the establishment that afford a panoramic, full frame view in order to accurately capture activities occurring within the entire licensed premises, with the exception of storage areas.”

Ordinance No. 12-07

To amend Chapter 5 of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine, Wisconsin relating to Hours of Operation of Convenience Stores and Gas Station/Auto Repair Facilities.

The Common Council of the City of Racine do ordain as follows:

Part 1:

Chapter 5, Section 5-8 of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine is hereby amended by amending the section to read as follows:

"Section 5-8. Hours of Operation.

(1) No holder of a license for a gas station/auto repair facility, whether operated in connection with retailing of edible or non-edible commodities, or both, shall sell or deliver any goods, wares, merchandise and personal property of any kind and nature to the ultimate consumer or the taking of an order therein for delivery therein of any goods, wares, merchandise and personal property of every kind and nature including any edible or non-edible commodities, including any sale or delivery for off-premises consumption, between the hours of midnight of any day of the week and 4:00 a.m. of that same day, anywhere in the City of Racine. If any provision of Chapter 22 or the Zoning Code, is more stringent as to hours of operation of businesses that are subject to this section, then Chapter 22 or the Zoning Code provision shall be given effect. Gas stations may keep one or more pumps open that can be operated by credit card when such stations are closed."

Part 2:

This ordinance shall become effective 60 days after its date of passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
