REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF: November

HIGHLIGHTS:

- The Racine Health Department has Influenza Vaccine for adults 19 and older and Vaccine for children 6months to 35 months. Flumist is available for healthy children 5-18 years of age. However, there is a shortage of vaccine for children 3-18 years of age.
- We received the final shipment of Influenza Vaccine for adults ages 19 years and older at the end of November. As a result of the late shipment, we are not seeing a demand for this vaccine.
- Public Health Nurses and the Immunization Nurse participated in two flu clinics for city employees on November 1 and 15. They also participated in the following flu clinics: Prospect Heights (11/7), Lincoln School Apartments (11/9), Danish Home (11/9), Elwood Getty (11/27).
