SUBJECT: Communication sponsored by Alder Horton on behalf of the City Attorney's Office submitting the claim of Jeffery Persons for consideration for disallowance.
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:
Claimant Jeffery Persons filed a claim with the City requesting an unspecified amount of damages to his vehicle allegedly caused by a Department of Public Works ("DPW") solid waste collection vehicle on February 15, 2024. Due to defects in the claim as filed and because there is no evidence that the City

2024. Due to defects in the claim as filed and because there is no evidence that the City caused the alleged damage to the claimant's vehicle, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office that this claim be disallowed.

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BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:

Claimant Jeffery Persons, of 5225 Douglas Avenue, Apartment 222, Racine, Wisconsin 53402, filed a claim with the City on August 2, 2024, requesting an unspecified amount of damages to his vehicle allegedly caused by a Department of Public Works ("DPW") solid waste collection vehicle in the vicinity of 1902 Linden Avenue on February 15, 2024. Due to defects in the claim as filed and because there is no evidence that the City caused the alleged damage to the claimant's vehicle, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office that this claim be disallowed.

The City cannot be held liable for this claim due to defects in the claim as filed. This claim did not statement of sought. include itemized the relief as required Wis. Stat. § 893.80(1d)(b). Furthermore, the notice of circumstances that the claimant filed with the City on or about August 2, 2024 was filed untimely. Per Wis. Stat. § 893.80(1d)(a), a claimant must file a notice of the circumstances of a claim within 120 days of the happening of the event giving rise to the claim. The event giving rise to this claim occurred on or about February 15, 2024; therefore, the notice of circumstances for this claim would need to have been filed on or before June 14, 2024, in order to be timely filed, which it was not. As such, this claim is not actionable under the law.

Moreover, the City did not have actual notice of the claimant's damages because neither the Department of Public Works nor the Racine Police Department were notified of this purported accident at the time it occurred or within 120 days thereafter. Due to this lack of notification by the claimant and the lack of any photographs of the damages, video of the incident, eye-witness statements or reports, or other evidence supporting the claimant's allegations, the City has no reason to believe that it is liable for the alleged damages.

For the reasons stated above, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office that this claim be disallowed.

BUDGETARY IMPACT:

Assuming the recommendation to disallow this claim is adopted, this item would have a \$0.00 impact on the City's budget.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

That the disallowance of this claim be recommended for approval.
