Dear Ms. Johnson-Martin,

The following report reflects calls for service regarding Licensed Premises which have been submitted to Investigator Jody Spiegelhoff.

**Rosie's Bar, 1333 Douglas Ave.**

**On 11-04-07 at 2330 hours**, two Racine Police Officers were working off duty at the American Legion and heard multiple gunshots coming from Rosie's Bar in the 1300 block Douglas Avenue. They observed an unknown person kneeling down behind a car in the parking lot of Rosie's, then quickly exit the parking lot. Other officers came into the area and located a gun on the ground near the tire of the vehicle the party was kneeling down in the parking lot. Officers talked to Rosie who stated that someone did come into her bar and say that someone was shooting outside. She did not call police because she saw police outside. The party who ran from the parking lot was identified and arrested. See reports.

**On 11-17-07 at 0100 hours**, an assault was reported by a female, MONICA WHITE. She stated that she was assaulted while in Rosie's bar by another female. It's unknown if the witness was able to identify the offender. See report.

**On 12-01-07 at 0100 hours**, there were multiple gun shots fired outside of Rosie's Bar. TERRANCE BLAIR was struck in the head; however, it was only a graze wound. He was somewhat uncooperative with police during the investigation. Officers arrived at Rosie's and observed freshly splattered soapy water on the ground outside Rosie's front door. This appeared to have destroyed blood evidence at the scene of the shooting. The case is currently open and no other information is available.

**Cera's Tequila Bar, 607 Sixth St.**

**On 12-08-07 at 0115 hours**, officers responded to a call for shots fired and several fights at the bar. This ended up being a homicide case and no other reports are available for viewing. See bar supplement only.

There were no other noteworthy incidents during the months of November and December. Please see the additional report regarding the November and December alcohol and tobacco compliance checks.
