Call To Order

Approval of Minutes for the December 14, 2011 Meeting

ORDINANCE NO. 15-11

To repeal Sec. 114-639, Development Review Committee, and recreate as Sec. 114-639 Development Review of the Racine Municipal Code of the City of Racine, Wisconsin.

The Common Council of the City of Racine do ordain as follows:

Part 1:

Sec. 114-39, Development Review Committee and Sec. 114-639, Development Review, of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

"Sec. 114-639. Development Review

- (a) The director of city development shall review applications for conformance with evaluation criteria established by the common council for all projects having an aggregate cost of \$5,000.00 or more for all new exterior construction activities, all building expansions, and all exterior renovation or rehabilitation activities.
- (b) The director of city development shall review all applications for exterior signs for conformance with evaluation criteria established by the common council.
- (c) Applications for design review shall be filed with the director of city development.
- (d) Review shall be conducted within 21 days after the application is filed with the director of city development or the activity shall be deemed approved.
- (e) The director of city development shall issue written findings to the

chief building inspector within the 21 day review period. The written findings shall indicate whether or not the proposed activity being reviewed meets the corridor evaluation criteria, and the findings shall be immediately transmitted to the applicant. If the evaluation criteria are found not to be met, the applicant may file revised plans for review by the director of city development addressing any deficiencies.

- (f) The chief building inspector shall issue building and/or occupancy permits within the corridor districts for projects requiring review, after receiving written approval by the director of city development or, in the event of an appeal, by the common council, except as otherwise provided herein, and in addition to other approvals required by law, ordinance or regulation.
- (g) An applicant may appeal a decision of the director of city development if the director of city development finds that the proposed activity is not in conformance with the evaluation criteria. Appeals shall be made to the city plan commission and filed with the department of city development. The appeal shall be filed with the department of city development within 30 days after the director of city development issues the written decision. The plan commission shall consider the appeal and make a recommendation to the common council within 30 days after the appeal was filed.

Part 2:

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and the day after publication.
