The Chief of Operations submitted the bid results on Contract W-16-4 in the amount of \$562,337.00 and recommended approval to the lowest responsible bidder, that being A.W. Oakes & Son, Inc.

5. <u>0230-16</u> Subject: Kinzie Avenue 2016 Water Main Replacement Agreement

Recommendation of the Waterworks Commission on 3/29/16:

Approve. Authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into a Joint Agreement with the Racine Water Utility for water main replacement in association with the reconstruction of Kinzie Avenue between Green Bay Road and Ohio Street.

Fiscal Note: The Racine Water Utility will pay for all work associated with the installation of a new water main.

The General Manager noted that the Water Utility is desirous to replace a water main on Kinzie Avenue in conjunction with the City of Racine doing reconstruction of Kinzie Ave. from curb line to curb line between Green Bay Rd. and Ohio St. The General Manager recommended approval and that this item be referred to the Public Works and Services Committee for approval.

6. <u>0231-16</u> **Subject:** Communication from Yorkville Wishing to Discuss a Retail Water Agreement
