- Contract duration: August 24, 2025 – October 24, 2025
- Contractor has been in touch with Purchasing and WRTP since before the pre-construction meeting, requesting RWP information and conducting interviews before the meeting.
- Contractor hired 2 RWP workers and stated that their subcontractor indicated they also had an RWP worker.
- Contractor was in contact with Purchasing throughout the project, having 7 phone calls.
 - Indicated problems of tardiness from RWP workers.
 - One RWP worker quit 2 weeks before the 2-month long project ended. The RWP worker quit on previous RWP projects after being hired.
 - The Contractor tried to contact WRTP but they were not responsive. Purchasing only became aware after the project was completed that WRTP was not staffed, and their phone system was not routing correctly.
- Payroll files submitted on November 20, 2025.
- The Contractor's entire staff are Racine residents. They will have their workers screened with WRTP for RWP certification for future project compliance and to give them more work opportunities.

Staff Recommendation: final payment for Tiger Restoration Tuckpointing LLC.

Contractor met 10% RWP compliance and made an effort to comply and be proactive with RWP.


