- Milwaukee General first completes a WRTP/BIGSTEP job order on 4/8/22.
- WRTP screened the RWP pool for her and referred 5 resumes of 5 interested participants.
  - Two were unresponsive
  - One never called back to schedule her interview
  - Two participants were interviewed
  - Milwaukee General decided to move forward with hiring TY on 6/13/22.
  - On 6/30/22, we received a very detailed email from Milwaukee General explaining how TY had quit the job.
- WRTP reached out to the RWP pool again on 7/5/22 to fill this position.
  - WRTP referred three resumes for review on 7/7/22.
  - Two of the participants were unresponsive
  - One was a no call no show to his interview.
- Milwaukee General completed another WRTP/BIGSTEP job order form on 9/14/22.
- WRTP screened the RWP pool again and referred three individuals over on 9/16/22.
  - One was unresponsive
  - One had been given a union sprinkler fitter apprenticeship that same day and was no longer interested
  - One interviewed
  - Milwaukee General moved forward with hiring AM on 9/19/22.
  - AM is still working with Milwaukee general.




- Contractor has submitted monthly payroll files
- Contractor has been in touch with the Purchasing
- Contractor is aware that if they bid on future projects as the prime contractor, they are responsible to comply with Racine Works Program.

**Staff Recommendation:**

Approve final payment for Milwaukee General Construction Co.

The contractor met 11% RWP Compliance and made a great effort to comply with RWP.
