*Subject: Calls to Licensed Premises 03-18-10 to 04-07-10*

**03-18-10** 0015 hrs. Kenny's – 1300 N. Main St. – 911 Hang Up / 911 Disconnect: Bartender advised officers that several parties were posturing to fight. Bar security escorted parties outside where the parties left prior to the arrival of officers. 10-13809

**03-18-10** 0115 hrs Gingers – 345 Main St.– Bomb Threat: A false bomb threat was called into Gingers. Unfounded call. 10-13810

**03-18-10** 0119 hrs. Vintage Rock Cafe – 3701 Durand Ave. – Fight: Officers responded to a call for 20 – 30 people fighting inside the bar, with one party down. Responding officers found one very intoxicated 25 y/o man bleed from the head outside of the bar. Employees report a fight involving the 25 y/o man, his unnamed brother, who officers report was very intoxicated and an unnamed black male. Other employees state the black male was trying to intervene in the fight between the two brothers. The bar manager reports the combatants sister was the main instigator in the altercation. No assault complaints where filed by anyone. Five officers on scene for 34 minutes. 10-13822

Blind Alligator – 1655 Taylor Ave.– Assault: Officers called to a residence where an 50 y/o intoxicated woman was complaining she was assaulted by another woman who was a bartender at the Blind Alligator. Officers report the victim had no signs of visible injury and he story did not make sense. The bar owner was interviewed and indicated the victim has a history of mental health issues. The Detective Bureau sent the victim a letter requesting additional information. 10-13842

**03-18-10** 1221 hrs. Demark's Bar – 1600 Albert St. – Assistance Requested: Officers called to Demark's Bar by a process server for assistance in serving legal paperwork on a man who lives above the bar. The man was not there. Not related to the operation of the bar. 10-13888

The officers found no evidence of the incident. They were unable to contact anyone from the bar, as the exterior gate on the front door was closed and locked. 10-16845
