#### **Outcome Achievements:**

- Two hundred and fifty five (255) children tested for lead poisoning had blood lead levels between zero and nine ug/dL (0-9 ug/dL).
- Preliminary reports identify that one hundred and one (101) children were <u>first</u> tested for lead poisoning; two (2) had an elevated blood lead level (>9ug/dL), or 2.0 %.
- Preliminary reports identify a <u>total</u> of two hundred and sixty six (266) children as being tested for lead poisoning; eleven (11) had an elevated blood lead level (>9ug/dL), or 4.1%.
- The final number of 2006 city dog licenses obtained is four thousand four hundred and fifty four (4,454).
- The final number of 2006 cat licenses obtained is one thousand one hundred and ninety (1,190).
- One hundred and three (103) pet fanciers' permits were issued in 2006.
