- E. The sponsor shall be responsible for the signing of the necessary detours for the State Highway route.
- F. The sponsor shall pay a \$250.00 special event fee.

Further recommend that the Commissioner of Public Works/City Engineer and Chief of Police provide any necessary assistance, in the interest of public safety, to implement this event.

**Fiscal Note:** There will be nominal costs incurred on a regular shift basis to provide limited assistance to implement this event.

#### Ordinance 13-12

To recreate Section 42-203(b), of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine, Wisconsin relating to application of fertilizers.

The Common Council of the City of Racine, Wisconsin, do ordain as

follows:

<u>Part 1</u>: Recreate Sec. 42-203 - Application, to add the following sentence to section (b):

"In no case shall fertilizer be washed, swept or blown off impervious surfaces into stormwater drains, ditches, conveyances or other water bodies."

<u>Part 2:</u> This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the City Common Council and publication or posting as required by law.
