Greetings,

On behalf of Racine Alternative Learning, I am writing to you regarding a fundraising event we intend to host at our school in partnership with My School Color Run. In accordance with city policies, I have included an event outline for your consideration:

Who: Racine Alternative Learning.

What: A 2 mile run/walk. The run will feature colored waters and powders at the start, middle (Lincoln Park) and end of the course. Coloring agents will only be used on grass surfaces, and are designed to be hypoallergenic and non-staining. The event will also feature a food truck and school concession stand, 50/50 raffle, silent auction, and music at the host location. Runners will be released in groups, and volunteers will be stationed to safely guide runners. First aid will be available at the host location. **When**: Saturday, May 19th, 2018; 9 AM - 2 PM.

Where: The run will start and finish at 2333 Northwestern Ave., on the Racine Alternative Learning grounds. Runners will run on city sidewalks guided by volunteers/signage. When not on city sidewalks, runners will be on grass along the curb (only occurs on Parks & Rec managed property), and on the Root River Pathway. Specific stretches are as follows:

- Sidewalk along Northwestern Ave from 2333 Northwestern Ave to Westwood Dr
- Sidewalk along Westwood Dr from Northwestern Ave to Maria Dr
- Sidewalk along Maria Dr from Westwood Dr to W. High St
- Curbside grass along W. High St from Maria Dr to Root River Pathway at Colonial Park
- Root River Pathway from Colonial Park to Lincoln Park where intersects Domanik Dr
- Curbside grass along Domanik Dr from Root River Pathway to Jefferson/Prospect Intersection
- Sidewalk along Jefferson St from Prospect St to Westwood Dr
- Sidewalk along Westwood Dr from Jefferson St to Northwestern Ave
- Sidewalk along Northwestern Ave from Westwood Dr to 2333 Northwestern Ave

Why: This event will serve as a fundraiser for Racine Alternative Learning. Funds will go towards student field trips, instructional materials and learning incentives. The event also provides students an opportunity to engage in service learning and community engagement as part of the event's volunteer staff.
