Second Chance Reentry Program (Racine Vocational Ministries)

Racine Vocational Ministry's Reentry Program is designed to reintegrate previously incarcerated Racine residents into the community and their families. The participants are selected by the Department of Corrections in which they are considered to be at high risk of returning to prison. This program offers case management support and provides a network of social, economic, job placement, educational and faith-based opportunities that are available to the offender as well as their families. These are low-income individuals.

Homebuyer Education & Counseling (Housing Resource Inc.)

Housing Resource Inc. will provide homebuyer education and counseling to low-to moderate income residents to enable then to secure affordable homeownership. Post-purchase education and counseling will also be offered to assist residents in maintaining home ownership. HRI's homeownership services will increase homeownership opportunities (per Consolidated Plan priority) and assist low to moderate income people in building wealth while helping to stabilize Racine neighborhoods.
