Dear Mayor Becker and Common Council:

The Downtown Racine Corporation is currently helping to organize a St. Patrick's Day Parade to be held in downtown Racine. The parade, with your approval, would be held on Saturday, March 15<sup>th</sup>, beginning at high noon. Because of the construction on 6<sup>th</sup> Street, the parade route will begin on the south side of the bridge (State & Main), and continue down Main Street to 9<sup>th</sup> Street.
