EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Communication sponsored by Alder Horton, on behalf of the Public Health Department, requesting permission to enter into an agreement and accept additional funding of \$150,000 from the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services for the Public Health Vending Machine program.

Background and Analysis:

Funding will be used to purchase and set up 2 additional vending machines, supplies to operate the machines, and insurance. Funds will also be used to purchase limited harm reduction supplies: injectable naloxone and administration syringe, nasal Narcan®, fentanyl test strips, packaging items and printed resource and promotional materials.

BUDGETARY IMPACT:

There is no City Match required.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

The Department be authorized to enter into an agreement and accept additional funding of \$150,000 from DHS for the Public Health Vending Machine program.
