30 • The affirmative action office is ex officio one of the 11 members of the affirmative action and 31 human rights commission. 32 • The city administrator is an alternate member of the waterworks commission—in the absence 33 of the mayor—by virtue of being the city administrator, pursuant to Racine Ordinances section 34 98-33(1). 35 • The wastewater utility general manager shall be a member of the board of standards, pursuant 36 to Racine Ordinances section 98-139. 37 For any employees who may now be serving on any authority, board, or commission, the prohibition 38 would take effect at the end of the employee's current term on such authority, board, or commission. 39 This is due to the requirement that, in order to be removed from their appointive positions, currently-40 appointed officials appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the common council are subject to the removal procedures set forth in Wisconsin Statutes section17.12(c). 41 42 This proposed ordinance would require the affirmative vote of more than half of the members of the 43 common council for passage. 44 45 **BUDGETARY IMPACT: None** 46 47 **OPTIONS/ALTERNATIVES:** Decline to pass the proposed ordinance or modify the proposed and pass the 48 ordinance as modified. 49 50 **RECOMMENDED ACTION:** 51
