

To the Mayor and Common Council:

We, the Downtown Rotary Club of Racine, request permission from the various councils in regard to the Rotary Post Prom to be held on Saturday, May 20 at the Racine Civic Center, Festival Hall.

- 1) Permission to extend the curfew for minors until 4:00 am Sunday, May 21st.
- 2) Special Events variance permit according to City Ordinance 11.14.080 to allow for the operation of a Karaoke machine in the small events area until 3:30 am Sunday, May 21st.
- 3) Permission to use the 5<sup>th</sup> Street Parking Ramp (with a token for each car) for the Post Prom attendees from 9:00 pm on May 20<sup>th</sup> to 4:00 am on May 21<sup>st</sup>.
- 4) Permission to hang banners at Racine Civic Center, Festival Hall
- 5) Permission to close streets and erect barricades where needed for the motorcade processions from each area high school.
- 6) Permission to use search lights at Festival Hall site on May 20<sup>th</sup>.
- 7) Permission to run the following interactive games in the colonnade area of Festival Park until 3:00 am Sunday, May 21<sup>st</sup>: Laser Maize, Gladiator Joust, Inflatable Twister, Quarterback Attack, Pop-a-shot, and Dance Machine
- 8) Special Events variance permit according to City Ordinance 11.14.080 to allow for the operation of a "Dessert Cabaret" tent, including and entertainment stage, in the Festival Park stage area (east of the colonnade) until 2:30 am Sunday, May 21<sup>st</sup>.
