Subject: Communication from the Chief Building Inspector/Weed Commissioner regarding revisions to the Racine Municipal Code Chapter 42 - Environment, Article 3 - Weeds.

Recommendation of the Public Works and Services Committee on 6-11-13: That revisions to Chapter 42 of the Municipal Code relating to Weeds be approved that will allow the City of Racine to issue one official notification letter per year to property owners who fail to keep weeds and/or grasses below 9 inches in height.
