Re: Amendment #2 to Contract 2024441 the Three-Party Agreement with the City of Racine, WisDOT and Baxter Woodman, Inc. for Consulting Engineering Services Agreement. For State Project ID: 2703-08-01/71, South Memorial Drive. (Limits: Durand Ave. to 17<sup>th</sup> Street)

We are submitting on behalf of the Commissioner of Public Works – Amendment #2 for the design contract for State Project ID: 2703-08-01/71, South Memorial Drive. (Limits: Durand Ave. to 17<sup>th</sup> Street).

The original contract is between The City of Racine, Wisconsin Department of Transportation and Baxter & Woodman, Inc. in the not to exceed amount of \$249,147.24. The first Amendment increased the contract \$21,352.30 to a total of \$270,499.54. This amendment will increase the contract to the not to exceed amount of \$278,824.38 and increase of \$8,324.84. (\$182,989.98 – WDOT, \$95,834.40 – City).

**Fiscal Obligation:** Funding for the City’s share was appropriated in the 2026-35 Capital Improvement Plan under Org-Object 45040-57500-Asphalt Pavement.

Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and directed to sign the Amendment #2 to the 3 Party Contract with Baxter & Woodman, Inc. and WisDOT.

If the Committee agrees, the appropriate action would be to direct the Mayor and City Clerk to sign the amendment to the agreement.
