Recommendation of the Traffic Commission on 10-19-15:

Recommends approval of charges for sign changes to schools will be made for requests associated with changes to arrival and dismissal times and bus pick-up/drop-off locations.

Fiscal Note: There will be nominal revenue generated based on these requests.

Mark Yehlen submitted a memo to the Traffic Commission members regarding policy language to request reimbursement from school officials to change street signage in the vicinity of schools. Mark noted that a reimbursement for time and materials would be required for schools requesting changes to parking restriction signage due to changes in arrival and dismissal times and bus pick-up/drop-off locations. He noted there would be no charge for signage changes associated with traffic engineering studies provided by the Engineering Department.

After further discussion, a motion was made by Wohlgemuth, seconded by Heckenlively to approve. Passed unanimously.
