- Karel Jonas statue at Douglas Avenue and High Street
- Soldiers Monument at Monument Square
- Gilbert Knapp painting/portrait in Common Council Chambers Room 205
- J.I. Case painting/portrait in Room 209.
- Bubbler at Zoo
- Soldier Statue at Mound Cemetery
- Cannons by Mound Cemetery (Washington & West Blvd.)
- Cannon at Washington and 12th Street
- Grieving Mothers/Harriet Lathrop statue in Mound Cemetery
