Dear Mayor Mason,

I am requesting the following regarding the Fourth Fest Parade and Fireworks to be held on Wednesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018:

1. Permits for the following road closures during the parade:
  - The Main and State street bridges to boat traffic from 7:45am until the conclusion of the Parade.
  - Main St. from Shoreland Ave. on the North side to 14<sup>th</sup> St. on the South side.
  - 14<sup>th</sup> St. from the lake to Racine St.
  - Michigan Blvd. for pre-parade staging from Goold St. to St. Patrick's St.
  - Ruby Ave, from South St. to Shoreland Ave. for float judging.
  - Walton Ave., Romaine Ave., Augusta St., Wolff St., William St., Isabelle Ave., and Melvin Ave. between Main St. and Green St. for Parade Staging.
2. Main and State St. Bridges be closed to boat traffic after the Fireworks on July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018. The Fireworks will run from dusk to approximately one hour after dusk (typically 21:30-22:30).
3. Permission to use the North Beach location along the North Pier to shoot the fireworks.
4. Permission to use the Walker Site for parking.
