SUBJECT: Communication sponsored by Alder Land on behalf of the City Attorney's Office submitting the claim of Albert Dunn for consideration for disallowance.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Albert Dunn, by and through his attorney, claims reimbursement in the amount of \$68,000.00 for damages arising from a purported injury he incurred when he was allegedly struck by a City of Racine bus in the 1900 block of North Main Street in Racine on or about September 7, 2022. The City denies that the Claimant was struck by a City bus on the date in question. As such, the City disputes the damages claimed and its liability therefor. For these reasons, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office that this claim be disallowed.

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:

The Claimant, Albert Dunn, of 30 Coolidge Avenue, Racine, Wisconsin 53403, by and through his attorney, Gregory A. Pitts of Schoone, Leuck, Kelley, Pitts & Pitts, S.C., 6800 Washington Avenue, Post Office Box 085600, Racine, Wisconsin 53408, claims reimbursement in the amount of \$68,000.00 for damages arising from a purported injury he incurred when he was allegedly struck by a City of Racine bus in the 1900 block of North Main Street in Racine on or about September 7, 2022.

The City denies that the Claimant was struck by a City bus on the date in question. As such, the City disputes the damages claimed and its liability therefor.
