Brownfield Activity Summary

Grant Management/Applications

- Received award notification for two Fund for Lake Michigan grants for West Bluff (\$95,000) and Belle Harbor (\$80,000)
- Authored/reviewed/submitted all necessary grant reports to US EPA and WI Coastal Management
- Received award notification for two of three grant applications to US EPA: \$400,000 Site Assessment grant and one \$200,000 cleanup grant for Racine Steel Castings
- Active participation and involvement in the RootWorks Project Management Team (bi-weekly) and new participation in the Machinery Row Project Management Team
- Sought approvals from RDA/F&P for DNR WAM grant (\$60,000) for Machinery Row properties
- Participated in Green Team meeting to discuss Machinery Row brownfields issues/funding and stormwater

- Project coordination for two BC-RLF projects: Harborside and Nelson Electric
- Participated in weekly project meetings for Harborside

State Grants (WEDC)

- Ongoing work/coordination of grant activities for Racine Steel Castings
