1. Sticky Rice is a neighborhood restaurant which serves a complete menu of authentic Thai food for lunch and dinner dine-in and take-out. We also offer a variety of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages.

Sticky Rice is located on the south side of Racine, at 203-207 Sixth Street, Racine, Wisconsin 53403.

Sticky Rice is the trade name of the business which is owned by Morakot Khampane as a sole proprietorship.

Morakot Khampane lives at 302 1/2 Sixth Street, Apt. 303 Racine, Wisconsin 53403.

2. The owner, Morakot Khampane, is the founder of Sticky Rice. He has more than eight years experience (2004 - 2013) managing this successful Thai restaurant in Racine.

3. Morakot Khampane successfully completed the ServSafe Food Protection Manager Certification Examination, accredited by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) on April 27, 2011. The Certificate number is 8173281.

Morakot Khampane's Operator's License will expire on June 30, 2013.

4A. Sticky Rice will offer a complete menu of Thai food as well as liquor wine, beer soda and other non-alcoholic beverages.

The primary product for Sticky Rice Restaurant will be traditional Thai food entrees with an emphasis on lightly prepared dishes with strong aromatic components. Sticky Rice will focus on high quality ingredients to distinguish itself from typical fast food outlets. Sticky Rice will provide 18-20 tables for customers to stay and relax and enjoy an unhurried meal.

4C. Sticky Rice is a neighborhood restaurant and most customers will frequent the restaurant through word-of-mouth from friends or family members. From past experience, the clientele will be predominantly caucasian.

4C. Sticky Rice will advertise in The Journal Times and in the Kenosha News.

5B. There will be two TV monitors which will show local news and weather at Sticky Rice.

6. Sticky Rice has ample parking available on the streets around Monument Square. There are several parking ramps also within easy walking distance.

#### 7. Competitors:

There are several restaurants in the immediate area which serve a variety of specialty ethnic foods.

There is a Chinese, a Japanese and a Korean restaurant, in addition to a Spanish restaurant, one serving International Cuisine, two shops selling takeout pizza, one national chain Sandwich shop, 3 Bar and Grill restaurants, a famous hamburger joint and a Chili and sandwich shop. This provides a wide diversity of dining opportunities.

Each of our competitors targets a different niche market. Sticky Rice can distinguish itself by providing traditional Thai food and by ensuring a warm and welcoming environment plus authentic Thai hospitality combined with good food and good value. We are the only Thai restaurant in Racine County.

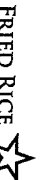

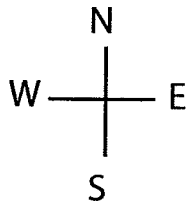

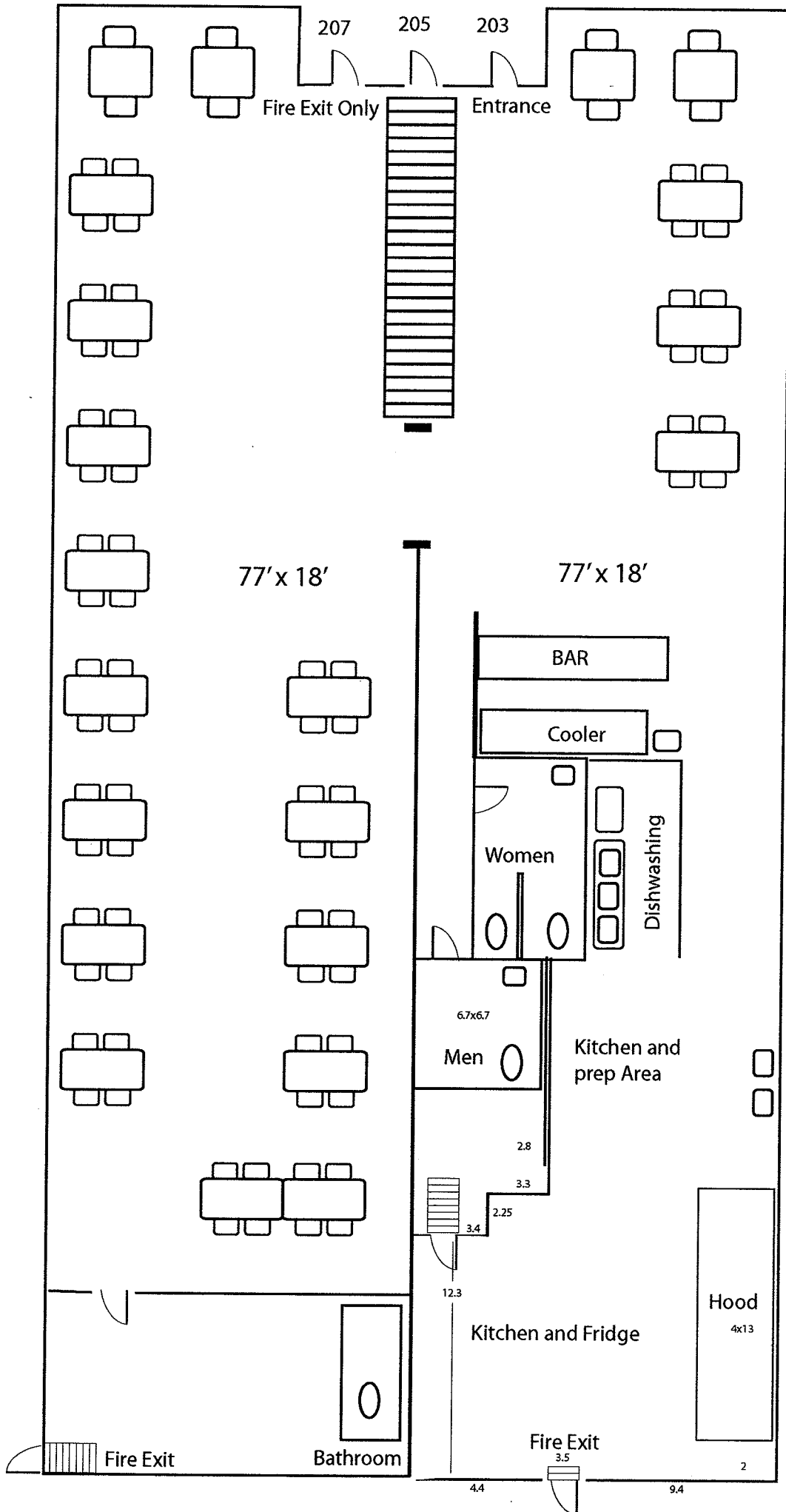
