Good morning,

I live at 1919 Deane Blvd and have been here just a year. I am wondering if there has been any consideration for making the intersection of 19th St and Deane Blvd a four-way stop. Presently the traffic stops on 19th St. Obviously I cannot accurately assess the speed of the traffic on Deane but since there are no stops between 21st and 16th St, it feels like people drive faster than is appropriate. I witnessed this morning a school bus stopped at 19th St heading East. They started into the intersection and a car traveling North on Deane was sounding his horn. It seemed to me that the car was going much faster than they should have and perhaps the bus hadn't seen them or didn't assess well the speed of the car. It is only one of many near misses that I have seen in this year. I have no idea what the number of accidents that have actually occurred over time at this intersection, but in my opinion, is a dangerous one. I just wanted to pass on my observations.
