Tobacco Control/Maternal and Child Health/Wisconsin Well Woman Program - The Health Department is currently working on new language for the 2009 memorandum of understanding between the City of Racine Health Department and the City of Racine Police Department to reduce the rate of illegal tobacco sales to minors.

Due to the budget shortfall, the State has pulled back the 2009 funds allocated to the City of Racine for the Wisconsin Well Woman Program and allocated a reduced amount for the first six months of the year.

Healthy Birth Outcomes - Due to decreases in funding the City of Racine did not receive the grant applied for from the Wisconsin Partnership Program, University of Wisconsin School of Medicine and Public Health.

Literature was passed out for a special event being held in February on behalf of the Racine Infant Mortality Coalition that invites invidividuals and families to view and discuss the PBS documentary that examines possible contributing factors of why the African American infant mortality rate is nearly four times the rate of Caucasian Americans.
