TOBACCO COMPLIANCE CHECKS, 6-28-10

Dear Ms. Johnson-Martin,

On July 14, 2010, Investigator Nicholas Groth was assisted by a 16 year old minor volunteer in conducting tobacco compliance checks in the City of Racine. They were able to check 20 establishments in the City. Out of the 20 inspections completed, three of the establishments sold tobacco to the underage volunteer. Three citations were issued for Tobacco Products to Minor Prohibited (clerk) and one citation was issued for Tobacco Products to Minor Prohibited (agent) since the owner was present at the time of the check. Two additional citations will be issued to the other two agents/owners of the violating business at a future date.

The establishments checked were all notified by mail of the compliance check per the Wisconsin WINS agreement.
