Use Supplement - 3500 Kinzie Avenue

Principal Planner Sadowski discussed the use supplement for 3500 Kinzie Avenue. At the previous Plan Commission meeting, the introduction of the Flex Development overlay for the property at 3500 Kinzie Avenue was provided to the Commissioners, and currently before the Commission is the Use Supplement for the property, which will allow the Beauty Salon as a conditional use, and will also prohibit other uses deemed unsuitable for the site. These uses are outlined in the supplement language and include community living arrangements; recreational clubs and community centers; religious institutions; family and group daycare centers; and retail sales, unless accessory to the principle use.

Commissioner Wyant questioned if it were in the authority of the Plan Commission to prohibit community living arrangements as noted in the use supplement. Planner Sadowski and Alderman Helding advised it would only be for this property, not a total city-wide ban of community living arrangements.

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Alderman Helding verified the applicant will not be allowed to expand the amount of signage beyond what currently exists, and that the applicant may only be allowed to improve the quality of the signage. Planner Sadowski verified that to be correct, and that such condition has been written into the Conditional Use.

A motion was made by Alderman Helding, seconded by Elaine Sutton Ekes, that this item be Recommended For Approval subject to Staff Recommendations. The motion PASSED by a Voice Vote.

Use Supplement - 2932 Northwestern Avenue

Planner Sadowski advised the additional use that will be allowed on this property via the approved Conditional Use as a Beauty Salon. Due to the land area involved, the prohibited uses on this site will be retail sales (unless accessory to the conditional use), and community gardens.

Alderman Helding questioned the process of choosing which uses will be prohibited. Planner Sadowski advised the decision is based on the uses allowed within the underlying zone district as conditional uses, and excludes those uses that may produce a hardship on the property.

It was verified that the hours of operation for the salon were modified, adding Saturday hours from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and that this has been updated in the conditions of approval for the Conditional Use.

Planner Sadowski advised the Public Works Department is looking to amend ordinance 81-123(b) of the Municipal Code requiring the minimum sidewalk width along Ohio Street to be six (6) feet. The area of concern at this time is between Washington Avenue and Durand Avenue, which do no meet the requirement.

Rick Jones, from Public Works, advised that per City Code, an ordinance is needed to require the six-foot width and that all sidewalk widths are set by ordinance within the City.

A motion was made by Jud Wyant, seconded by Vincent Esqueda, that this item be Recommended For Approval. The motion PASSED by a Voice Vote.

Planner Sadowski discussed recent updates to the new Comprehensive Plan that is underway and due to be completed by 2010.
