Dear Property Owner:

The City of Racine Planning, Heritage and Design Commission has received an application from Luis Bautista representing L-A Tires LLC seeking a major amendment to a conditional use permit to allow an automobile sales facility at 1626 Douglas Avenue as allowed by Sec. 114-468 of the Municipal Code.

The application contemplates having an automobile sales facility in an existing automobile repair establishment for the sale of up to eight (8) vehicles. The hours of operation would be from Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Saturday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and closed on Sundays.

The subject property is zoned B-2 Community Shopping District. The specific location is shown as "Subject Property" on the map on the reverse side of this page (flip page over).

A public hearing has been scheduled by the Planning, Heritage, and Design Commission for **Monday, June 3, 2024 at 4:30 p.m., or soon thereafter**. The hearing will be held in Room 205 of Racine City Hall 730 Washington Avenue, Racine, WI 53403.
