Ord.12-15 Ordinance 12-15 - Breweries and Brew Pubs

An ordinance to amend Chapter 114 - Zoning, of the Municipal Code of

the City of Racine, Wisconsin.

The Common Council of the City of Racine, Wisconsin, do ordain as

follows:

Part 1: Amend Sec. 114-467(1) by adding after the words "where

produced" the words "except as permitted herein".

<u>Part 2:</u> Create Sec. 114-468(11) to read as follows: "(11) A brewery, a brewery with a restaurant, or a brew pub, each as defined by Wis. Stat. §§ 125.29 and 125.295, and producing less than 1,000 barrels per

year."

Part 3: Create Sec. 114-568 (39) to read as follows: "(39) Brewery as defined by Wis. Stat. § 125.29."

<u>Part 4:</u> Repeal and recreate Sec. 114-587 (b) (39) to read as follows: "(39) Breweries as defined by Wis. Stat. § 125.29."

Part 5: Create Sec. 114-587 (40) to read as follows: "(40) Reserved."

<u>Part 6</u>:This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the City Common Council and publication or posting as required by law.
