THE CLUB

- 3/6/2008 "CLASS B" LICENSE GRANTED TO MARIO ARANDA
- 2/2/2008 On 02-02-08 at 0207 hours, multiple officers responded to 13th Street and Washington Avenue for a fight. When City officers arrived there was already one RCSD squad on scene who advised he heard several gunshots as he was pulling up to the fight. According to the RCSD squad, when he pulled up about 30 people ran into the parking lot and behind the building, and then he heard the shots being fired. City officers stopped two males, one white and one black, who came out from behind the bar who were later released. The bartender advised that he had a busy night and the bar was at capacity at 1:00 a.m., at which time he shut the outside lights off and didn't allow anyone else in the bar. The bartender indicated the only problem he had that evening was with two females who got into it outside the bar as people were leaving. He stated he didn't hear any shots being fired. No citations or arrests.
- 11/20/2007 LICENSE WAS GRANTED BUT NOT ISSUED DUE TO BLDG & FIRE DEPT APPROVALS WERE NOT SIGNED OFF.
- AS OF 2-26-08 - CLERK STAFF CALLED AND INFORMED MR. ALONZO THAT HE DID NOT HAVE A VALID LICENSE AS BUILDING DEPARTMENT INFORMED CLERK'S OFFICE THAT HE HAD NOT APPLIED FOR AN OCCUPANCY PERMIT. MR. ALONZO INFORMED THE CITY CLERK STAFF THAT HE WOULD BE IN BY MONDAY, MARCH 3, 2008 TO APPLY FOR THE OCCUPANCY PERMIT.
