## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

Patricia Caldwell filed a claim with the City requesting \$898.00 for property damages allegedly arising from a privately-owned tree that fell into the backyard of a residence she owns at 941 Villa Street in Racine and tore off the electrical mast from said house on or about June 3, 2024. The tree that fell was a privately-owned tree located on the neighboring property at 939 Villa Street. Because this tree was not owned by the City, the City is not responsible for the maintenance of the tree in question, nor is it liable for any damages caused by such tree. For this reason, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office that this claim be disallowed.

22 BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:
