RE: DeRango's Restaurant located at 3114 Washington Avenue — Install two (2) 6" steel bollards at south and east elevation of existing structural column for safety concerns.

Dear Mayor Becker & Racine City Council:

We are concerned that our customers are incurring a potential safety hazard when entering and exiting our restaurant. The location of our entrance seems to be a target for west bound traffic. We are currently rebuilding our front entrance for the forth time as we have been hit by vehicles from Washington Avenue traffic.

Would it be possible to have some type of traffic barriers installed on the north side of Washington Avenue, east of the restaurant, to help slow down traffic heading west on Washington Avenue?

We feel that in order to protect our customers and the tenants that live above our restaurant, we should have two (2) steel bollards installed around the main structural support located at the southeast corner of our restaurant. Please see attached drawings showing the location of these proposed bollards.
