## Approval of Minutes for the April 10, 2006 Meeting.

## 1. <u>06-1785</u>

Subject: Communication from Chief of Police Spenner, requesting to apply for the 2006 Bureau of Justice Assistance Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program grant, at no cost to the City. Grant control number 2006-011.

Recommendation of the Finance & Personnel Committee 04-24-06: That the Chief of Police be granted permission to apply for the 2006 Bureau of Justice Assistance Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program grant (Grant Control No. 2006-011) to be utilized for the purchase of bulletproof vests.

# 3. <u>Ord.14-06</u>

Ordinance No. 14-06 to repeal and recreate Sec. 2-402(b) of the Municipal Code relating to Chief of Police.

To repeal and recreate Sec. 2-402(b) of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine, Wisconsin relating to Chief of Police - Supervision of department.

The Common Council of the City of Racine do ordain as follows:

Part 1:

Sec. 2-402(b) of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

"(b) Supervision of department; deputy chiefs.

The chief of police shall have general supervision over the police department and be responsible for the efficiency thereof. In the event of a temporary absence of the chief of police, his duties shall be performed by the deputy chief of police designated by the chief of police, and in the event of the disability, death or suspension of the chief of police, his duties shall be performed by the deputy chief of police of the patrol division."

Subject: (Direct Referral) Request from the Interim Fire Chief to meet with the appropriate committee to apply for a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) fire grant to replace fire department apparatus.

Recommendation: That the Interim Fire Chief be granted permission to apply for \$375,000 Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) fire grant (Grant Control No. 2006-020) to be utilized for the replacement of the fire department's apparatus.
