EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This is part of a multiple storefront building at 314 Sixth Street. Applicant Andrew Meyer received a White Box grant for the 322 Sixth Street portion of the building to transform the first floor into a restaurant space. Mr. Meyer is applying for a White Box Grant of \$8,510.00 to renovate the vacant, first floor commercial space at the address of 324 Sixth Street for retail use.

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:

The property at 314 Sixth Street is more than 100 years old. This White Box grant application envisions the renovation of 1,615 sq. ft. (324 Sixth Street – currently vacant) into a white box space that would be used as retail space.

Proposed renovations include: updating the electrical and HVAC systems.

- White Box Request: \$8,510.00Square Feet (first floor): 1,615 s.f.
- Total Costs: Range between \$17,020.00 \$18,781.00

This item appeared before the Downtown Design Review Committee prior to this meeting.

BUDGETARY IMPACT:

The initial White Box program had a budget of \$100,000. In July, Common Council added \$150,000 to the budget for additional White Box incentives for 2017 and combined the line items for White Box and Façade Grants into one "pot" of money for a total of \$400,000 available in 2017. To date, the RDA has awarded \$111,545 in White Box grants, reaching \$156,925 inclusive of the applications currently being presented to the RDA*.
