Dear Mayor Dickert and Members of the Common Council:

The purpose of this letter is to submit the Uptown Neighborhood Strategic Development Plan ("Plan") and respectfully request its adoption by the City.

In 2012 City leaders determined the need to prioritize the various redevelopment opportunities within the City. To complete this process, the City asked RCEDC to prepare a Request for Proposal to solicit interest from planning firms. Interviews were conducted and in the end, RCEDC engaged the services of Vandewalle and Associates ("Vandewalle") to conduct a project opportunity analysis.

Vandewalle hosted a variety of listening sessions and gathered feedback from the community regarding 11 different Opportunity Areas in the City. Through a scoring process, it was determined which of the 11 Opportunity Areas had the greatest potential to serve as a catalyst for economic development. Their conclusions were summarized in the November 9, 2012 "Racine Economic Development Project Opportunities" report. Within this report the greater Uptown Neighborhood was identified in the top three areas as having significant redevelopment potential.

Several of our staff have served on the Uptown Project Management Team ("Team") and have been party to this planning process. The work performed by the Team and Vandewalle was rigorous and comprehensive in its approach. We were especially impressed with the efforts to reach out to the community to inform them of the ongoing planning process and the direction that the Plan was taking.
