RE: Formal Expression of Concern against Pub on Wisconsin, 525 Wisconsin Ave

Dear Mr. Wensing,

Please be informed that the Public Safety and Licensing Committee of the Common Council of the City of Racine will meet at 5:00 P.M., on Wednesday, January 28, 2026 in room 303, City Hall, pursuant to a formal expression of concern issued against you as it relates to the licensed premises located at 525 Wisconsin Ave, Racine, WI, 53403, under section 6-27 of the City of Racine Code of Ordinances. Specifically, the relevant issues include but are not limited to the following incidents:

12/12/2025 – Pub on Wisconsin – 525 Wisconsin Ave – Officers were dispatched in reference to an assault report. Officers located a victim who was eventually transported to Ascension for medical treatment. Victim did not consent and a report was taken in reference to the incident. The physical altercation was captured on video and was entered as evidence. A license premise report was completed and no violations observed. **25-058873**

12/14/2025 – Pub on Wisconsin – 525 Wisconsin Ave - Officers were dispatched in reference to a welfare check. Female party left the bar and a license premise report was completed. No violations observed. **25-059138**

12/27/2025 – Pub on Wisconsin – 525 Wisconsin Ave – Officers were dispatched in reference to a man with gun call. Parties outside and staff inside advised there was a verbal altercation between two males while inside the bar. Staff advised they did not observe a firearm during the altercation. Contact was made with one of the parties involved and a firearm was not located. Second party involved left prior to police arrival. At this time, it is unknown if a firearm was used/pointed during the verbal altercation. A license premise report was completed and no violations observed. **25-061054**

01/03/2026 – Pub on Wisconsin – 525 Wisconsin Ave - Officers provided extra attention and did not observe any violations. **26-000323**

Sec. 6-27. - Actions by the committee.

(a) Formal expression of concern. (1) The public safety and licensing committee may require the appearance of any licensee before the committee at any time to address issues related to the licensed premises through a written formal expression of concern, sent via first class mail to the licensee. (2) If the licensee fails to appear for the formal expression of concern, the committee may refer the matter to the city attorney's office for consideration of further disciplinary action. (3) If the licensee appears for the formal expression of concern, no discussion of the alleged facts may be permitted unless the licensee requests such discussion and only after the licensee has been advised that any statements made by him or her and/or his or her representatives regarding the alleged underlying facts may be considered by the due process board in any subsequent suspension/revocation hearing which may result from the alleged violations which are the subject of the formal expression of concern. (b) Referral for disciplinary proceedings. (1) Any licensee who has been issued two formal expressions of concern within a six month period, or three or more formal expressions of concern within a one year period, shall be referred to the city attorney's office for consideration of further disciplinary proceedings as contemplated under section 6-26 of this Code. For purposes of this section, the date the committee votes to issue a formal expression of concern shall be the date used to calculate any time period prescribed. (2) Nothing in this section shall be construed to conflict with, abridge or modify, the rights or procedures established for revocation or suspension of licenses in Wis. Stats. § 125.12 provided there is cause for disciplinary proceedings under the relevant ordinances or statutes.
