WHAT IT IS: We are requesting use of the two block sidewalk **OR** parking lane area on the south side of State Street, East of Lake and West of the turnaround. This is to extend the St. Pat's Day 5K route which will be incorporated into the St. Patrick's Day Parade. The area west of this is already closed to traffic and reserved for staging a by the DRC for the Racine St. Patrick's Day Parade.

WHEN: From 12:00pm to 1:00 pm, Saturday March 16, 2019

No streets will be closed for this extension. We prefer Parking lane at this location, however the sidewalk area is sufficient for our purpose.

Hi Nancy - The run is part of the St. Patrick's Day Parade - All streets being used are already reserved by the DRC for the St. Patrick's Day Parade.

We would utilize the parade route during the St. Patrick's Day Parade, the only change is we would extend our route to include the Lake Michigan Pathway to complete the 5K. SEE:

1. At Lake and State there will be Police directing traffic and runners. We will utilize this crossing for about 10 minutes in total.
2. We are fine using the sidewalk east of state and lake, but if the parking lane is available we would like to use that when runners are going east only because they will already be utilizing the street lane east of Lake and State (This is shut down to traffic during the parade)
3. On the return, the side walk area is more than sufficient for our needs.
4. See area on map below outlined and highlighted in blue - This area as I understand it was not reserved by the DRC for the parade.
