The Village of Mount Pleasant is going to consider a staff proposal to make an application to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for a grant from the Transportation Alternatives Program for the Safe Routes to School Program. The Village intends to apply for new sidewalk in front of the J.I. Case High School. We have discussed this potential project with the principal of Case H.S., Mr. Mark Eben. He will be working with the Racine Unified School District to try and obtain their approval to have the sidewalk extend across their entire property. If the City of Racine is interested in partnering with the Village, I would suggest that the Village be the lead agency to apply for the grant and seek to have the new sidewalk be extended from Washington Avenue to Durand Avenue. We would ask if you would consider having your Public Works Committee consider this proposal. Applications are due December 13, 2013. I would plan on 2015 construction.
